Raising a child/children who are deaf/hearing impaired provides unique challenges and rewards. Often it can be helpful to connect with other parents who can relate to your experiences. WHAT IS POD?

POD is a support group for all parents, carers and family who have children that are impaired.

WHO CAN JOIN?

Parents, families, grandparents, caregivers of children with any degree and type of deafness

WHAT DOES POD DO?

Provides peer support to parents, carers and families without any bias of communication method (ie sign language or oral) they have chosen for their children.

LEVEL OF COMMITMENT

Participants can choose their level of commitment. Come along to our regular meetings and/or participate in our activities.

Monthly meetings alternate between social meetings and discussion/planning meetings. Child minding can be arranged and interpreting is provided (if pre-booked).
